2021 Louisiana Broadcasting Hall of Fame

The Louisiana Association of Broadcasters presents the *Louisiana Broadcasting Hall of Fame* that honors retired or posthumously individuals who were pioneers of the industry and made significant, revolutionary contributions to the growth and development of broadcasting and their community in Louisiana.

The LAB Hall of Fame award is bestowed upon individuals in all aspects of the broadcast industry; ownership, production, management, engineering, news, sales, promotion, on-air talent, creative services or associated professional fields. Nominees must have a Louisiana background by birth, residence or employment.

Inductees of the LAB Hall of Fame award have reached the highest levels of achievement, success and dedication in their professional lives to the advancement and welfare of radio and television broadcasting on a local and/or national level.

LAB Radio and TV members will each receive an opportunity to submit a nomination for this award until the deadline, February 3rd, 2022. Final selection for the award will be held at the discretion of the LAB Board of Directors. Submission of a nominee is merely an application for consideration and does not assure any guaranty of this award.

The Louisiana Broadcasting Half of Fame will be presented at the 2022 Prestige Awards. Location and time to be announced.

Hall of Fame Nomination

To nominate a Louisiana broadcaster to the LAB Hall of Fame, please answer in detail the following below. You may send along an attachment of up to three pages of materials supporting the candidacy of the nominee. If any nominee is not selected for 2020 LAB Hall of Fame, their nomination may be considered if applied for in the following years.

Nominations should contain a cover page listing the full name of nominee, company/station/call letters, their home address, e-mail address and telephone number.

The LAB Board of Directors will judge nominations on the following criteria:

1. Longevity as a Louisiana Broadcaster

Nominee must have been a Louisiana Broadcaster for a minimum of 20 years.

2. Broadcast Career

A brief biography or resume of the nominee's career as a broadcaster.

3. Dedication to Broadcasting

During their career, how has the nominee shown industry leadership and innovation in promoting the development and growth through their work in local and/or national level?

4. Significant Contributions to the Profession

The nominee must have achieved the highest level of broadcast success in Louisiana. List nominee's major career highlights, awards and/or recognition received.

5. Reason Nominee Should be an Inductee

In your own words and personal view, elaborate why this nominee should be inducted in the LAB Hall of Fame.

****Note**** Upon acceptance of nomination, a photo of the nominee is required.
