The Louisiana Association of Broadcasters presents the the Louisiana Broadcasting Hall of Fame that honors retired or posthumously individuals who were pioneers of the industry and made significant, revolutionary contributions to the growth and development of broadcasting and their community in Louisiana

The LAB Hall of Fame award is bestowed upon individuals in all aspects of broadcast industry; ownership, production, management, engineering, news, sales, promotion, on-air talent, creative services or associated professional fields. Nominee must have a Louisiana background by birth, residence or employment.

Inductees of the LAB Hall of Fame award have reached the highest levels of achievement, success and dedication in their professional lives to the advancement and welfare of radio and television broadcasting on a local and/or national level.

LAB Radio and TV members will each receive an opportunity to submit a nomination for this award until the deadline, January 23rd, 2026. Final selection of this award will be held at the discretion of the LAB Hall of Fame Committee. Submission of a nominee is merely an application for consideration and does not assure any guaranty of this award.

The Louisiana Broadcast Hall of Fame will be presented at the 2026 Prestige Awards on March 19th, 2026 at the Baton Rouge Marriott.

Hall of Fame Nomination

To nominate a Louisiana broadcaster to the LAB Hall of Fame, please submit the following:

- A video entry that does not exceed 5 minutes demonstrating the significant and revolutionary contributions the nominee has made to Louisiana broadcast industry.
- A :30 second clip with sound to be present at the Prestige Awards if selected as an inductee,
- A written narrative answering all 5 criteria points listed below,
- A quality picture of the nominee.

Below you will find the criteria for the written narrative part. Please deeply elaborate on how the nominee has met and/or exceeded each of the criteria points. You may attach up to three pages of supporting material for the nominee's candidacy. Additional information or letters may be included in the nomination. If a nominee is not selected for the 2025 LAB Hall of Fame, their nomination may be considered again if applied for the following years.

Nomination should contain a cover page listing the full name of the nominee, company/station/call letters, their home address, e-mail address and telephone number.

The LAB Board of Directors will judge nominations on the following criteria:

1. Longevity as a Louisiana Broadcasters

Nominee must have been a Louisiana Broadcasters for a minimum of 20 years.

2. Broadcast Career:

A biography or resume of the nominee's career as a broadcasters.

3. Dedication to Broadcasting

During their career, how has the nominee shown industry leadership and innovation in promoting the development and growth through their work in local and/or national level?

4. Significant Contribution of the Profession

The nominee must have achieved the highest level of broadcast success in Louisiana.

List the nominee's major career highlights, awards and/or recognition received.

5. Reason Nominee Should be an Inductee

In your own words and personal view, elaborate why this nominee should be inducted into the LAB Hall of Fame.
